Conditions of Stud Service

1. A copy of the Dam's Registration Certification, a record of current vaccinations and proof of de-worming within 6 months of the breeding date, must be given to the owner of the Stud Dog before breeding takes place.
2. One or more puppies constitute a litter.
3. The Dam will reside with the owner of the stud dog during the full breeding period.
4. The owner of the Stud dog is responsible for the reasonable safety and health of the Dam during the breeding period.
5. The owner of the Stud dog will undertake to have the Dam only mated to the identified Stud dog.
6. Sire will provide a return service one (1) time to the same dam if no pregnancy results from the mating at no charge. To receive return service, the dam owner must notify the Stud dog owner of failure to conceive, in writing, not more than 60 days following the mating. Lack of notification as indicated above will forfeit any return service.
7. If the Dam develops any illness or requires veterinary care during the stud service period, the owner of the Dam would be responsible to remove the Dam from the Stud owner immediately and agrees to pay all veterinarian and associated costs.

Fees

Dam owner agrees to pay Stud dog owner:

- a) A non-refundable stud fee of \$1,500 / Exact selling price of one (1) puppy

OR

- b) Stud owner has the right to one (1) puppy, which will be selected by the Stud owner, and will be the first pick of litter, made within the first two (2) weeks of the puppies being born.
